

<b>RCH</b> Pitchfork 4.3%	A golden bitter with floral citric hop aroma. It has a hoppy predominate taste which is slightly sweet and fruity and leaves you wanting more
<b>Robinsons</b> Olympic Gold 4.0%	Harvest gold premium bitter with a distinctive citrus fruit aroma. This smooth, full bodied, bitter beer has a clean, soft and refreshing palate perfectly balanced by both spicy and orangey citrus fruit notes
<b>Rooster's</b> White Cloud 4.3%	A clear wheat beer. Softly hopped, light with raspberry aromas
<b>Saltaire</b> Bavarian Gold 4.2%	This Munich Helles style beer is a true classic; lightly toasted, biscuity Vienna malts give body and light malt flavour, while a light dosing of Saaz hops provides a spicy, resinous hop quality.
<b>Skinner's</b> Cornish Knocker 4.5%	A strong, clean tasting golden ale, not too sweet with a fresh flowery aroma.
<b>Surrey Hills</b> Gilt Complex 4.6%	A huge hop aroma introduces the beer. There is a hint of spice in the fruity flavour and a long finish that completes this classic beer
<b>Springhead</b> Liberty 3.8%	Pale gold made with Liberty hops, very refreshing with hints of lemon
<b>Stonehenge</b> Eye Opener 4.5%	Eye-Opener is a beautiful golden, dry and smooth premium bitter with a hint of toffee, which compliments the citrusy and spicy flavours
<b>Surrey Hills</b> Ranmore Ale 3.8%	A straw coloured session beer that has a surprisingly full flavour for its strength. A pleasant and distinctive aroma is followed by a moderate hop bitterness
<b>Surrey Hills</b> Shere Drop 4.2%	The flagship beer is pale in colour with a subtle hint of grapefruit and lemon in the aroma. The wonderful hop bitterness is complemented by a balanced malt flavour. The beer has a long finish, which is moderately dry
<b>Triple fff</b> Alton Pride 3.8%	A full-bodied golden brown session bitter. A forward hoppy aroma with a long bitter finish
<b>West Berkshire</b> Maggs Magnificent Mild 3.8%	A traditional dark mild, not too sweet and very popular

<h2>Surrey Oaks</h2> <h3>August Beer Festival 2008</h3>	
<b>Acorn</b> Crystal 5.0%	One of the brewery's single varietal 'IPA' series. Well hopped and aromatic
<b>Allendale</b> Jacksnipe 3.5%	Single hop with Fuggles, caramel coloured with a delicate slightly citrus taste
<b>Arundel</b> Sussex Mild 3.9%	A traditional, deliciously dark and smooth mild
<b>Bob's</b> Yakima Gold 4.5%	A hoppy, bitter, yellow beer brewed using hops from the Yakima Chief ranch in Oregon, USA
<b>Boggarts</b> Oliver Clough 4.2%	A pale ale, light with a hoppy and lemon citrus flavour
<b>Bowman</b> Swift One 3.8%	A pale, golden quaffing ale with excellent flavours for its strength. Pleasingly hoppy throughout without being aggressive and also possessing of a fine aroma. The finish is dry with a small twist of sweetness at the end.
<b>Bushy's</b> Shuttleworth Snap 4.0%	Brewed to honour TT legend...(See the film!) George Formby, this bright, dry IPA style bitter has a particularly refreshing character
<b>Crouch Vale</b> Summer Breeze 4.2%	Featuring classic Boadicea hop character and best quality Maris Otter barley
<b>Dark Star</b> Sunburst 4.8%	A strong, bitter - refreshing with a dark golden straw colour and hoppy aroma
<b>Dark Star</b> Hophead Extra 5.8%	Hophead's big brother brewed to a higher strength but retaining the clean light and quaffable characteristics that Hophead fans love
<b>Downton</b> German Pale Ale 4.2%	A clean tasting, golden coloured beer with plenty of hoppy bitterness, subtle fruit flavours and aroma. Brewed using pale malt and a little crystal malt, together with Three varieties of German hops

<b>Dunham</b> Massey Dunham Stout 4.4%	Creamy & full bodied with all English ingredients, a dry stout with a classic bitter finish with burnt dark roast flavour
<b>Elland</b> El Divino 4.6%	Blonde Premium bitter made using the intensely aromatic and flavoursome Marynka Hop from Poland to give a pleasant floral resinous and herbal aroma, finished with American Mount Hood
<b>Empire</b> Golden Warrior 3.8%	A pale bitter, quite fruity with a sherbet aftertaste, moderate bitterness
<b>Flowerpots</b> Terracotta 4.2%	A mid-brown beer with a superb red hue. Not too bitter or hoppy, allowing the malt to show
<b>George Wright</b> Pipe Dream 4.3%	A straw coloured, light and fruity ale with a hint of grapefruit that leaves a lingering malty dryness in the mouth
<b>Grindleton</b> Ribble Rouser 3.8%	Made using only Maris Otter Pale Ale Malt it is very pale in colour with a distinctive hop character and bitter finish
<b>Harvey's</b> Sussex Best 4.0%	A full, well-hopped bitter with a reputation that exceeds the borders of its native and adjoining counties
<b>Harviestoun</b> Schiehallion 4.8%	The original cask conditioned lager beer Schiehallion is crisp, dry and airy with a beautifully fresh, grapefruity taste. Delicately crafted using Hersbrucker lager hops; it is fermented at a very low temperature with lager yeast
<b>Hepworth</b> Traditional Sussex 3.6%	Flavoursome light brew using Goldings hops. This gives a full flavour with a traditional Sussex hoppy nose to the beer
<b>Hogs Back</b> Summer Pale 4.2%	A light copper coloured beer, sweet initial taste tempered by hop bitterness breaking out to quickly counterbalance. Finishing with hoppy dryness then malt in the aftertaste
<b>Hop Back</b> Summer Lightning 5.0%	Straw coloured with a characteristic very fresh hoppy aroma and an excellent long, dry finish

<b>Hornbeam</b> Black Coral 4.5%	A smooth dry roast malt, dark and full bodied with a rich creamy head. Satisfying with subtle bitterness
<b>Kelburn</b> Carte Blanche 5.0%	Named after Paisley's river, White Cart Water, this golden full-bodied ale boasts smacks of flavour. The appearance is enhanced by a touch of wheat malt, giving good head retention and a wonderfully dry after-taste that won't be easily forgotten
<b>Loddon</b> Check Mate 4.8%	A Czechoslovakian style Pilsner brewed with low colour Cara malt and Saaz hops. The result is a beer that's appealing to the eye and sensuous on the palate
<b>Marble</b> Lagonda IPA 5.0%	Deceptively robust, this classic IPA is golden, dry, bitter and dangerously moreish. A quadruple addition of hops lends it a depth and complexity rarely achieved on other beers
<b>Naylors</b> Old Ale 6.2%	A dark amber coloured beer with fruity malts a smooth taste with a hint of sherry.
<b>Oakham</b> White Dwarf 4.3%	Piercing bitterness in this 'brite' English style wheat beer, mellows to reveal fruit overtones amidst a dry as a bone finish. A real thirst quencher.
<b>Oakleaf</b> I Can't Believe it's not Bitter 4.9%	Clean and crisp with a fruity aftertaste. The use of Saaz hops gives this lager a citrus finish that lingers on.
<b>O'Hanlon's</b> Port Stout 4.8%	Simply unique and unequalled. A black beer with a roast malt aroma, that remains in the taste but gives way to hoppy bitterness in the finish.
<b>Ossett</b> Beijing Gold 4.4%	Premium strength, golden hoppy bitter. Citrus/spicy hoppiness.
<b>Pictish</b> Motueka 4.5%	A pale bitter, tropical fruit edged, full bodied and hoppy
<b>Pilgrim</b> Burton Smoked Ale 3.8%	Known as Templar, this is a departure from the normal Pilgrim leaning towards malt. Brewed with Burton yeast, Burtonised water, low colour malts and a dash of Bavarian beech smoked malt
